- "Class night has been the highlight of my week."

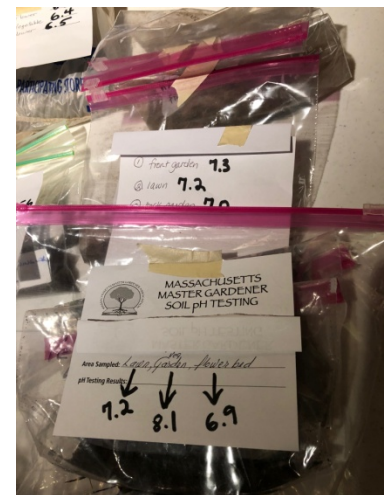
